

## Believing Forward!

I have good news for you today. God's P.E.A.C.E. plan includes **you!**  
*"... just as Abraham 'BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS ACCOUNTED TO HIM FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS' ... So then those who **are** of faith are blessed with believing Abraham."*

Galatians 3:6,

We also, just like Abraham have the right to "believe God." Every time you believe God, every time you look at God's ability rather than your own, and put your trust in what He has done, it will be accounted to you as righteousness as well.
