## Have Life! More Abundantly!

John 19:36 & John 20:31 boldly declares:

"For these things were done that the Scripture should be fulfilled . . . But these were written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name."

The Prophets foretold of the coming of the Redeemer. Truly, Jesus Christ is the fulfillment of all prophecy. The prophetic Word reveals Christ: that was its purpose. So, we possess current testimony and tradition, the written testimony of the New Testament writers, the historical record of the Apostolic fathers, the historical record of a historical Jesus, the witness of the Holy Spirit in our hearts, and, finally, the Old Testament prophets who foretold all of these events. The uncanny accuracy of the fulfillment of scripture is the greatest evidence to reveal who Jesus truly is. You see, He *is* the Word made flesh! He *is* the One who spoke to the Prophets and told them what to write down in the first place – that we might believe! And Jesus declared to us all:

"I have come that you may have life, and life more abundantly!"

This Easter Season may the life of God overtake all that you do!
