## Rewards of P.E.A.C.E.!

God empowers us in conflict. Look what Paul declared in 1 Thessalonians 2:2.

"But even after we had suffered before and were spitefully treated at Philippi, as you know, we were bold in our God to speak to you the gospel of God in much conflict."

The early church faced opposition but this did not prevent them from being what He asked them to be! Notice it says "in much conflict."
