## Surrounded by Harvest!

Do you not say, 'There are still four months and *then* comes the harvest'? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest! John 4:35 NKJV

And he who reaps receives wages, and gathers fruit for eternal life, that both he who sows and he who reaps may rejoice together.

John 4:36 NKJV

For in this the saying is true: 'One sows and another reaps.' John 4:37 NKJV I sent you to reap that for which you have not labored; others have labored, and you have entered into their labors." John 4:38 NKJV
